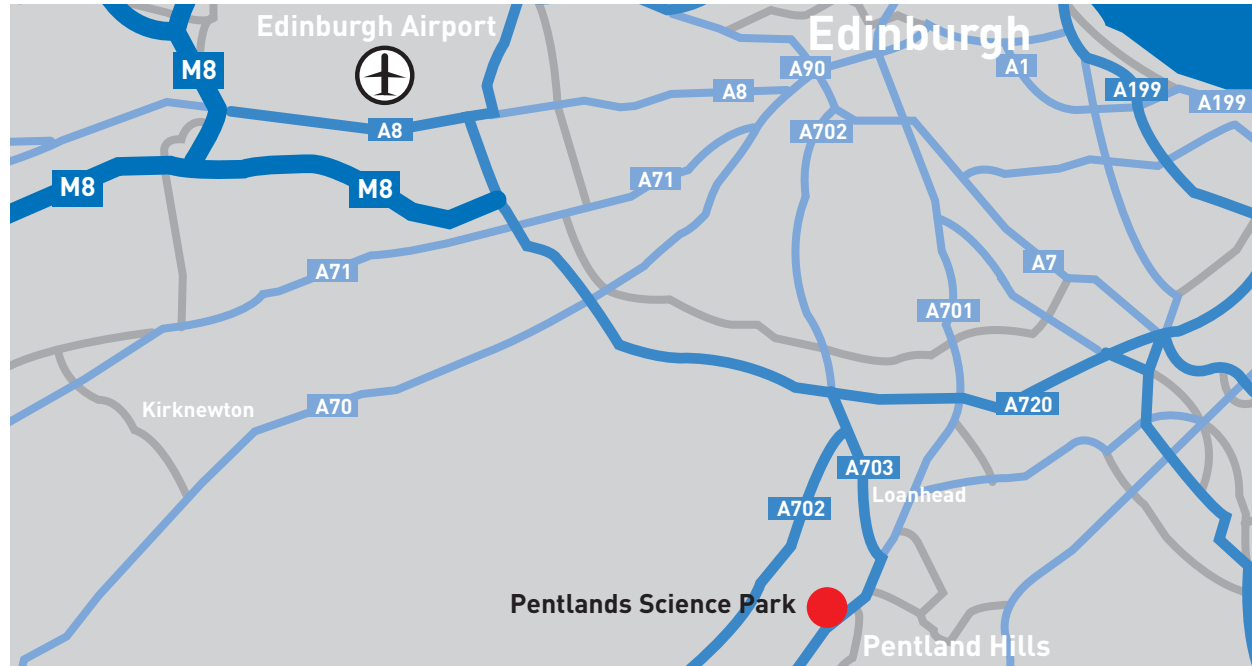
## Pentlands Science Park

In addition to the Moredun Research Institute, the Park is home to over 20 organisations including Moredun Scientific, which carries out contract research for pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies. International companies located here include Viragen (immunological products and transgenics), Hycor Biomedical (manufacture of diagnostic products) and Schering Plough (salmon farming science). Other tenants consist of the Veterinary Laboratories Agency, Applied Generics, Biobest and The Laboratory of the Government Chemist, which recently established a BSE testing laboratory on site

## Pentlands Science Park

**Pentlands Science Park is home to (and part of) the Moredun Group – an internationally recognised animal health and welfare charity renowned for its research into diseases of livestock, particularly sheep. Moredun Research Institute leads the field in animal disease research and veterinary science with over 160 staff working within its three main divisions: parasitology, virology and bacteriology. Although the Park is centred around veterinary science, other sectors are represented including life sciences, environmental consultancy and software development.**

The Park extends to 22 acres and provides high quality office and laboratory accommodation for the Moredun Group and other tenants.

The strength of the veterinary science benefits from strong links with the University of Edinburgh (Moredun and the University have a joint laboratory on site), the Royal Dick Veterinary College and the Scottish Agricultural College – both of which are located in the immediate vicinity of the Park.

World-class animal clinical facilities are located on site allowing Moredun and other organisations to complement laboratory based research with animal studies. Their use varies from field studies in traditional buildings to studies carried out in the high containment accommodation, which meet the highest clinical standards.

Located in an attractive rural setting just minutes from the Edinburgh City Bypass and eight miles from the city centre, the Park offers high quality office and laboratory space to commercial and research organisations.

### **Accommodation and facilities**

A range of space is available from 700 sq ft to 2,500 sq ft, with ample secure parking provided. A number of support services are provided including IT, engineering, security, waste disposal, cleaning, stores and on site refectory. Conference facilities including a tiered lecture theatre for up to 104 delegates, boardroom and other meeting rooms with full equipment provision and technical support are also available to tenants and outside clients.
